Ninth Summer Academy of Dermatopathology *Graz, July 2-6, 2012*

The ninth Summer Academy of Dermatopathology will be held July 2nd – 6th, 2012 at the Convention Center, Graz, Austria. The Course will focus on clinicopathologic correlation of inflammatory skin disorders. In addition, sessions will be devoted to melanoma and nevi, cutaneous lymphomas and pseudolymphomas, and other benign and malignant tumors of the skin.

The Course will be held at a projection microscope aided by digitalized projection of clinical pictures, and is restricted to 90 persons in order to maximize active participation of all registrants. There will be no formal lectures, but sections of hundreds of cases, including a broad spectrum of "typical" presentations, unusual variants, and rare cases of skin pathology will be reviewed at the microscope and discussed thoroughly during 5 days of full-time dermatopathology. In all cases of the Clinicopathologic Conference and in many of the other cases the clinical picture pertinent to the section scrutinized by microscope will be projected and discussed in the context of clinicopathologic correlation. In addition, relevant ancillary techniques (immunohistology, molecular biology) will be presented and discussed as well.

Course Location

All sessions will be held at the Convention Center, Schmiedgasse 2, Graz (www.mcg.at/congress). The Convention Center is conveniently situated in the center of the city and is within a walking distance from most major Hotels.

The aim of this Course is to provide information that can be applied immediately to dermatopathology practice, as well as to discuss problematic and controversial aspects that represent a daily conundrum in this field. The interactive outlay of the Course will maximize active participation of all registrants and allow continuous discussion and comments.

On July 4th there will be a dinner at a restaurant on the "Schlossberg", offering a magnificent view of Graz. The restaurant can be reached by the "Schlossbergbahn", a funicular trundling up and down its tracks on a 61% gradient since 1894.
