Riding on the excitement of the Paris 2024 Olympic games, which will be held in July, the ISDP will organize an online competition in which residents, trainees, and fellows from various countries can solve challenging cases.

1) Who can take part in the competition?

Pathology residents, dermatology residents, and trainees/fellows in dermatopathology can participate. It is not necessary to be an ISDP member to take part in the challenge as a competitor or spectator.

Professors and assistants should not assist. It is a competition for residents and trainees.

2) When and where will the competition take place?

Date: Saturday, June 15, 2024

The meeting will be completely online.

Time: CDT (US): 9:00am – 11:00am (UTC +05:00)

3) How do I form a team?

A team consists of 3 members. Only one designated member per team will be responsible for submitting the team's official answers. This member must be specified in the registration form. Teams can have members from different countries or from different Universities, Hospitals, Services or Institutions.

4) How will the competition take place?

Many challenging dermatopathological cases will be presented, and the participants will answer questions concerning the microscopic diagnosis and related issues.

5) If I am not participating as a competitor, may I watch the competition as an attendee?

You are most welcome to attend as a spectator. A link to watch the competition will be available on the ISDP website closer to the date.

6) How can my teammates and I register for the competition?

A registration link will be provided online via the ISDP website during the period from May 1st to May 15th, 2024

7) When will my teammates and I receive confirmation of registration?

Team members will receive an official email confirming the registration by May 31, 2024.

8) What are the prizes?

The three teams with the highest scores will receive the gold, silver, and bronze awards respectively. These prizes are non-transferable.

Gold award (worth over USD \$700 + special prize)

- 1-year free ISDP membership and an online AJDP subscription for the team members (3 pax), non-transferable
- 50% off registration for the 28th ISDP Joint Meeting in Orlando in 2025 (3 pax), non-transferable
- Special prize: 30 minutes online with a dermatopathologist of the team's choice from a list of those who volunteer or agree to make themselves available
- Certificate of Gold Award

Silver award (worth over USD \$700)

- 1-year free ISDP membership and an online AJDP subscription for the team members (3 pax), non-transferable
- 50% off registration for the 28th ISDP Joint Meeting in Orlando in 2025 (3 pax), non-transferable
- Certificate of Silver Award

Bronze award (worth over USD \$300)

- 1-year free ISDP membership and an online AJDP subscription for the team members (3 pax), non-transferable
- Certificate of Bronze award
